Resolution Recommending Dr. Douglas Askman as an Honorary Mamo Hawai'i Member of the Royal Order of Kamehameha I, Hawaii Chapter

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there are leaders within the community in Hawai'i who are committed to protecting and perpetuating the Hawaiian culture and history; and

WHEREAS, Article VIII (Membership), Section 9 of the By-Laws of the Royal Order of Kamehameha I (October 18, 2008) provides for the granting of Honorary Mamo Hawai'i Membership to deserving individuals; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Douglas Askman of Honolulu, Hawai'i, has expressed the sincere desire to contribute his knowledge and services to the Royal Order of Kamehameha I by providing periodic presentations on relevant and diverse Monarchy-era topics. These presentations might include important personages in the history of the Hawaiian Kingdom, including sovereigns and other ali'i, the royal residences of Hawai'i, and Hawaiian royal orders. Specific themes could be decided in consultation with the officers of the Order. In addition, Dr. Askman would be able to offer special tours of 'Iolani Palace for groups of members; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Douglas Askman in September 2010 gave a presentation at the Bishop Museum for the Royal Order of Kamehameha I entitled "An Insider's Guide to 'Iolani Palace"; and in December 2010 gave the Founder's Day speech in honor of King Kamehameha V for the Royal Order of Kamehameha I at Mauna Ala, the Royal Mausoleum; and will be able to assist Royal Order of Kamehameha I in mentoring Hawaiian youth in the history and culture of and Hawai'i; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Douglas Askman is an Associate Professor of History at Hawai'i Pacific University and obtained his Ph.D. in History from the University of California at Los Angeles. He has published scholarly articles on the Hawaiian monarchy, including "Her Majesty's Disloyal Opposition: An Examination of the English-language version of Robert Wilcox's *The Liberal, 1892-1893*" (*Hawaiian Journal of History*); "Royal Standards of Hawai'i during the Kalākaua Dynasty," *The Friends of 'Iolani Palace Quarterly*; "Louis Philippe, King of the French," *Ke Kukui, The Friends of 'Iolani Palace Volunteer Newsletter*; "Hawaiian Princess Involved in Dispute over Throne," *Monarchy* (London); "Prince Edward Keliiahonui Kawanakoa (Obituary)," *Monarchy* (London); "The Hawaiian Monarchy, Parts I and II," *Monarchy* (London); and

WHEREAS, Dr. Douglas Askman has been a Docent at ‘Iolani Palace since 2001, conducts tours of the Palace and participates in numerous Friends of ‘Iolani Palace events; and has demonstrated his competence of Hawaiian and European history by the following presentations at ‘Iolani Palace: “King Kalākaua’s Foreign Orders of Chivalry;” “Frederick William III and Frederick William IV, Kings of Prussia (The People of the Portraits: The State Portraits of European Monarchs at ‘Iolani Palace);” “Robert Wilcox and the Hawaiian Monarchy, 1892-1893;” “Napoleon III, Emperor of the French (The People of the Portraits: The State Portraits of European Monarchs at ‘Iolani Palace);” “Louis Philippe I, King of the French, and Alexander II, Tsar of Russia (The People of the Portraits: The State Portraits of European Monarchs at ‘Iolani Palace);” and

WHEREAS, it is deemed correct and proper, and the wish of the Ali‘i ‘Ai moku ‘O Hawai‘i and **FOR THE GOOD OF THE HAWAII CHAPTER & THE ORDER**; therefore be it,

RESOLVED, that Dr. Douglas Askman be admitted as an Honorary Mamo Member of the Royal Order of Kamehameha I, Hawai‘i Chapter.
